## Resolution for Imperial Convention

**WHEREAS**, the 2024 Imperial Convention will be held in Reno, Nevada, June 30 through July 4; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Assistant Rabban, Robert B. Creech, to make arrangements to house the members of Boumi Shriners in Reno, Nevada, during the aforesaid Convention; and to make said arrangements at the time of the 2022 convention in Minneapolis, Minnesota; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to subsidize the expenses of the members of Boumi Shriners who attend the 2024 Convention and to offset others expenses associated with official Temple functions and activities in connection with said Convention, it is directed to make available the sum \$50,000.00 as needed

to the 2024 Operating Budget Account #23805 of Boumi Shriners; any unused funds to be returned to the Financial Officers of Boumi Shriners.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Assistant Rabban, Robert B. Creech, be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the 2024 Imperial Council Housing Committee in order to provide housing for the members of Boumi Shriners who desire to attend the said Imperial Council Convention and to make such monetary deposits as required; and **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors of Boumi Shriners be, and they are hereby authorized to make available funds to meet the expenses outlined in this Resolution in the amount not to exceed \$50,000.00; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Potentate then in office shall cause a detailed accounting of the monies spent according to the foregoing resolution to be rendered to the Temple at a stated meeting in writing, within 90 (ninety) days after the close of the 2024 Imperial Session.
